

Delinquency Intervention Grants for Duplin County

The North Carolina Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention anticipates allocating grant funds in the amount of \$169,150 to Duplin County for programs to serve delinquent youth and youth most at risk to become delinquent for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.

The Duplin County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council will be accepting proposals from local government agencies and private non-profits with 501-c-3 status for the following services:

1. Restitution/Community Service
2. Parent/Family Skillbuilding
3. Interpersonal/Experiential Skillbuilding
4. Temporary Shelter
5. Psychological Assessment
6. Teen Court Services
