

## DEBRIS PICK UP - PREPARE NOW

Removal of residential vegetative debris, construction & demolition debris, etc. will begin soon on county roads. Please place debris by public roadsides for pick up now so our contractor can pick it up when they come through the county.

Debris must be piled separately by type on public right-of-ways to be eligible for pick up. The actual dates that our pick up contractor will travel through the county are forthcoming, but we ask residents to work on locating their debris by the roadside now. Collection will only be made on public, state-maintained roads. We do not collect items on private roads. Roadside debris pick up is provided at no charge to the resident.

### Debris Types

- Vegetative Debris – includes shrubs, tree trimmings, grass and leaves, twigs or downed trees cut into manageable lengths.
- Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D) – materials relating directly to construction or demolition of buildings, such as cement, dry-wall, glass, insulation, concrete blocks, etc. Only construction debris resulting from Hurricane Florence will be removed from residential property.
- White Goods Debris – appliances, including refrigerators, ranges, washing machines, clothes dryers, freezers, microwave ovens, air conditioners, etc
- E-Goods Debris – Electronics, including TVs, computers, stereos, phones, DVD players, etc
